Product Description: SeekBeak is a SaaS platform that allows people to add interactivity and information to 360 images, flat images, 3D models, and Gaussian Splats, then embed or share their works. This report covers the viewer experience — the publicly shared/embedded interactive viewer that end users interact with, including overlays, hotspots, and navigation. The visual overlay editor, admin dashboard, and account management interfaces are out of scope.

Evaluation Methods Used:

- Assessments are completed using both manual and automated testing tools. Primarily analysis consists of 60+ TSX viewer components, 45+ CSS module files, and supporting store/primitive files.
- Manual keyboard-only navigation testing of all viewer interaction flows.
- Manual testing at 200% browser zoom.
- Review of ARIA attributes, semantic structure, and focus management patterns.
- Contrast ratio estimation from code-level color values and CSS custom properties.
- Usability testing with people with disabilities are conducted, as well as contracts for 3rd party organizations.
